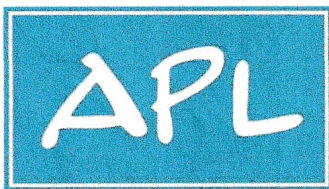
I thought the one hour training was very good on the top-

The four training sessions were:

- **Wisconsin Library Law.** This is similar to training by Robin Stowe and state statutes on what we should know: open meetings laws, your authority, legal research and much more.
- **What You Need to Know about AI and Libraries.**
- **Board Documents 101.** Done by a Certified Professional Parliamentarian. [Compare standard order of business with an agenda. Consider the value of a consent agenda. Review the content of board minutes and how to approve them. Review the hierarchy of governing documents. Explore what's in your bylaws and what you need to look up most often. Review how to amend or suspend rules (or not). Consider some Frequently Asked Questions]
- **All Playing in the Same Orchestra: Collaborating for Community Services.** The relationship between a library board and its municipality or county is unique to other appointed boards in the community.
