

Dear Town of Neva Resident:

Wisconsin law bans the disposal or incineration of many recyclable materials. It also requires municipalities to operate recycling programs in order to facilitate recycling throughout the state. Thus, the Town of Neva's recycling program requires residents to separate recyclables for recycling.

At the bottom of this letter, we have provided a brief list of items that should and should not be recycled. - Aluminum bottles & cans

- Window glass
- Ceramics & china
- Drinking glassware

- Shredded paper
- Tissue paper
- Pet food bags

METAL

- Propane tanks
- Aluminum pans & foil
- Empty paint cans
- Scrap metal
