- O. Public Comments:**
- Hwy B North of the state wetland project. There are 3 big culverts and Tony and Jason Nagel have been asking the County to re-ditch the road.
 - Little Chicago Rd and Hwy C and Hwy V intersection as well needs to be brushed out. Discussion held.
 - Tony asks if there is a need to spray the ditches. He said that the Town of Price a truck to spray with. Discussion Held.
 - Angel has a question about getting info on new road construction. County meetings are open to the public and there will be more info there about any road construction on the county level. Discussion held.
 - Mike says that knowing the cost of redoing the roads and then the cost of snowplowing he wants the board to consider when doing the budget that we increase the budget whatever we were short the last year or two. So that we can show the voters what we would have to pay. And the comp committee that they need some forms so that they can put together the info about the land to submit to the committee. And that we need to establish a day every month to have a planning meeting so that everyone can keep that day open. Discussion

held. He wants to see about having an application fee to cover some of the cost of the meetings.

- f. Jason has a question on if the chair has a protocol about how to handle problems. He brings up the complaints about the trucks driving on roads in the spring. He wants there to be more investigating and protocols followed to figure out how to figure out who to call about it. Discussion held.
- g. Peg says that Gaudette went and did a history by Josephine and he did a good job. She says there were two drawers that had histories in them and they are gone now. She says that neither of the desks were hit by the truck and wonders if anyone knows where they could have gone. Doug has some of the pictures she was looking for and will be putting them into a new album. Discussion held. She also needs help from Tom and Bev to work on Labor Day Weekend. He said he will talk to Bev and get back to Peg. Also she asks Doug if he is talking to Otto because she wants to leave jugs of water under the trees for him to water the petunias when they are wilting. The last thing she has a question about putting large rocks in the ditch in front of the school. Discussion held. Tony asks if there is a way to make benches with electric poles in front of the school to protect it. Further discussion held.
