Double-entry security doors with locked vestibules, requiring visitors to be screened and pass through two controlled entry points, including lockdown buttons to instantly secure doors in an emergency.



Technology systems for mass communication in all classrooms and offices for immediate emergency response, including surveillance systems covering all entry points, hallways, and exterior areas.



Upgraded exterior and interior classroom doors that remain secured and locked at all times.



Safe student drop-off and pick-up zones that are not located on a public road to control traffic flow and ensure student safety.



Upgraded fire alarm systems with improved response protocols and sprinkler systems.



School design to minimize the number of exterior alcoves or courtyards to eliminate "dark spots" where individuals can hide.



Improved exterior lighting and upgraded security fencing around the perimeter for added safety.
