What is CrimeStoppers?

CrimeStoppers is a program which involves
the public, the media and law enforcement in
a fight against crime.

CrimeStoppers offers anonymity and cash rewards to
persons who furnish information leading to the arrest
of offenders, capture of fugitives, and expose illegal
drug activity, location of stolen property or other
information that helps solve crimes.

Langlade County **CrimeStoppers** was founded in
June, 2006 and became part of the Wisconsin State
CrimeStoppers organization.

Who Administers the Program?

The **CrimeStoppers** board of directors is comprised of
concerned citizens from the Langlade County area
who oversee the operation of the program. Their
responsibility includes establishing policy, raising
funds and controlling the amount of reward
payments. Crime information is provided by
local law enforcement coordinators.

What is P3 Tips?

P3 Tips mobile app is available on the iOS and Android
platforms, greatly enhancing the mobile tip submis-
sion process. Still completely anonymous, tips submit-
ted through the P3 mobile app have no length limita-
tion and allow images, video and documents to be
uploaded with the tip. Encryption processes obscure
any and all identifying information and provides
assured anonymity for tipsters." Search for "Antigo"
under the Wisconsin locations to get hooked up to our
Langlade County **CrimeStoppers** application.

How Does It Work?

When a call or P3 Tip is received by **Crime Stoppers**
it is logged with the date, time and a brief summary
of the caller's information. Callers and P3 tipsters will
be given a TIP ID and password. With this information
they can login at p3tips.com and submit follow-up
information, be informed of the outcome of the tip,
and access any pertinent reward information.

Callers may remain anonymous.
There is no pressure to reveal their identity and they
can still collect their rewards.

If a caller's information results in the arrest of a
criminal or the apprehension of a fugitive,
arrangements are then made so the caller can receive
the reward in CASH and still preserve their anonymity.

Quick 100

The **Quick 100** program is designed to identify and
confiscate drugs, weapons or alcohol currently in our
schools and help deter anyone from bringing in
those types of contraband in the future.

Quick 100 offers a way to report, remain anonymous,
and become eligible for a Cash reward. The purpose
of **Quick 100** is school safety and to create a safe,
relaxed environment for all students and faculty.
