- G. Wildman Holdings LLC – Update/Info only:** Angie and Doug did a walk through of the facilities earlier today. All updates are either completed or started. We will be finalizing the idle site grant and getting the grant money distributed to Wildman Holdings as soon as everything is processed. Michael is the manager of the location and says that all updates are 70% done with the geothermal energy being completed a few months ago. There are no plans to expand the facility they would look into expanding into the industrial park in Antigo have additional space.
- H. Electrical Port for Town Hall:** Tony states that he talked to other townships and says that most of the townships do not have a generator or they use their fire departments generator. Two of the townships have a generator and one has a port if needed. He says that a rough estimate for a port is \$1500 - \$2000. Discussion held.
- I. Large Door-drapes or replacement:** Doug says he didn't have much time to look for products to use on the door.
- J. Resolution for Transportation Funding:** The WTA is asking all the towns to pass this resolution to benefit all townships. Tony makes a motion to approve the resolution, Doug seconds. Doug Curler-aye, Herb Ullman-aye, Tony Koss-aye, motion carried.
- K. Radon Test:** Doug states that there are test kits available to residents.
- L. 6-20' Structures:** The state looked at all the structures within parameters. There were only 4 in Langlade County that were rated poorly enough to be repaired, Neva had none.

- N. Junk Yard/Cty. B:** They will be given until the spring clean up before more steps are taken, as was suggested in November.

- a. We are waiting for our attorney to get back to us regarding the liquor license transfer to Elcho.
 - b. Tony will get bids from the county and another sign maker for the cemetery rules. Discussion held.
 - c. On the corner of B and J in Kempster there is a request to add to April's agenda to ok the removal of the old house and to rebuild in the same footprint. Discussion held.
 - d. Tom says that the RFC met last night. Mike says that they have decided on a different manufacturing facility to build the truck. The RCF will pay \$5,000 to get the process of the truck to get started. It will be made in Marion at Custom Fabrication they can start working on it as soon as they get the downpayment. In August or September, a payment of \$74,231.00 will be needed and a balance of \$33,431.00 paid 18-24 months later.
