- G. Junk Yard/Cty. B – Forward:** Both places received the certified letter notifying them of the spring clean up to reduce the cost of cleaning the junk from their yards. Herb says one of the houses brought a load in on Friday, and that they will be getting a dumpster delivered to their house to continue cleaning the yards. Doug makes the motion to move ahead with County Ordinance 11-05 in continuance with not allowing more than the set number of non-running and unregistered cars, Tony seconds. Discussion held. Doug Curler-aye, Herb Ullman-nay, Tony Koss-aye, motion carried.
- H. Town Mower Use:** Doug states that the town mower is to be used on town property or for township purposes. Herb says that they were looking at the mower, and he thinks we need to purchase a new string trimmer as the old one is not useable. Tony makes a motion to approve the purchase of the string trimmer from Fullers for approximately \$295.91. Herb seconds. Doug Curler-aye, Herb Ullman-nay, Tony Koss-aye, motion carried.
- I. Liquor License Transfer – Info to Winter:** Doug says he sent more info to Winter about the law that changed that allows purchases to be within the county. Winter has not replied yet so there have been no updates. We must make sure that the check clears before the license is transferred. Discussion held.
- J. Logging Town Dump – Update:** Doug says he got a letter from Ted stating that Solin will extend the contract to 4-7-27 for timber on the township land. Doug makes a motion to approve extending the contract, Herb seconds. Doug Curler-aye, Herb Ullman-nay, Tony Koss-aye, motion carried.
- K. Roads – Price-Neva:** We are still waiting for Price to get the approval for LRIP funds. Discussion held.
- L. EM Grant – March 2026 Info:** Doug says that the emergency grant for the 30+ inch snowstorm. We put in for a \$7500 refund on emergency costs. We have submitted the info needed for the grant so we may receive all or part of it.
- M. RFC:** Tom says that they met last night, and all three towns agreed to buy the tanker. The truck has been ordered and will be delivered late summer. It will then go to get the tank added. Discussion held.
- N. NCWRPC Outdoor Recreation Plan:** There is a questionnaire from northcentral regional planning commission. Neva was invited to the board will review and we will submit it in June at the Board meeting.
- O. Pay bills:** Tony makes a motion to approve the bills, Herb seconds. Doug Curler-aye, Herb Ullman-aye, Tony Koss-aye, motion carried.
